Nomination of shares on your death:

You can nominate a person (aged 18 or over) or organisation to whom you wish your shares to be transferred on your death. The Society will respect your wishes insofar as the law and our rules permit.

You could choose to nominate SWR Community Pub Limited which would in effect make it a beneficiary under your will.

The society can redeem up to £5000 in shares without needing a Grant of Probate subject to the Society having sufficient funds available.

If you choose not to nominate anyone your executors will deal with your shares as part of the administration of your estate and can apply to have them redeemed
